

Literacy

Fiction

The children will be looking at stories with a transport theme, as well as higher level texts, including Roald Dahl's *James and the Giant Peach*. We will look at different ways to start a sentence, and explore stories with recurring literacy language.

Poetry

The children will be learning how to write and structure calligram poems, and will create their own based on a *Wheel, Wing or Other Thing!*

Non Fiction

The children will be learning how to write reports, using the Talk for Writing approach

ICT and Computing

Animation

Children will learn to use technology purposefully to create, organize, store, manipulate and retrieve digital content.

Learn the 2x, 5x and 10x table and recognise relationship between multiplication and division.

Use scientific vocabulary to name and describe the properties of common materials.

Make a materials collage.

Make observations and carry out investigations to find how different materials can change over time.
