

## Literacy

We will continue our topic of toys. Children will listen to fictional stories and poems.

Texts will include:

Christmas poetry

Children will take part in a phonics scheme called Read Write Inc to improve their knowledge of sounds for reading and writing.

Children will write instructions for how to create Mr Potato Head after creatively making this themselves.

## Science

Materials will be continued -

Children will be learning all about what a material is, what they might be used for and where they come from. They will do this through a range of investigations, sorting activities and exploring their indoor and outdoor environment.

Children will be taught to think scientifically.

Animals including Humans (begun)

Children will begin to look at the human body and explore it by identifying, naming, drawing and labeling the basic parts. They will also learn about the senses and which body part is associated with each.

## ICT and Computing

Mrs Lynch to over ICT. This term we will be Digital Sound.

### Number and place value - key area for Autumn

Multiplying by 2 practically by calculating the answer using concrete objects, pictorial representations and arrays and beginning to record in number sentences.  
Dividing by 2 practically by calculating the answer using concrete objects, pictorial representations and arrays and beginning to record in number sentences.  
Recognise, find and name half as one of 2 equal parts.  
Describe position, direction and movement including half and whole turns.

Begin to measure lengths and heights.

Begin to tell the time to half past and o'clock times.

## History & Geography

Children will learn about the history of toys. This will include looking at old toys and comparing them to toys today.

Children will begin looking at the four countries and capital cities of the UK and its surrounding seas.

This links to our PHSE cultural lessons and assemblies (e.g. St Andrew - Scotland).

## RE and PSHE
