

## Literacy

### Fiction

The children will be looking at the traditional tale 'Hansel and Gretel' focusing on the characters, setting and their own re-telling of the tale as well as continuing to explore higher level class texts, including The BFG.

### Poetry

The children will be looking at calligram poems and the features of these. They will then create their own!

### Non Fiction

The children will be continuing to learn how to write instructions, using Pie Corbett's Talk for Writing approach.

## Science

Children are taught to work scientifically through the topic of **Everyday materials and their uses.**

Children will;

Identify and compare the suitability of a variety of everyday materials, including wood, metal, plastic, glass, brick, rock, paper and cardboard for particular uses.

Find out how the shapes of solid objects made from some materials can be changed by squashing, bending, twisting and stretching.

Find out about some of the physical properties of different materials.

## ICT and Computing

### Programming

Children will use LOGO to produce sequences of commands. They will use this to create shapes, words and pictures.

### Measures

Recognising and using pounds and pence symbols and combining amounts to make a particular value.

Children will be continuing to learn about the Great fire of London and following our trip to the discovery museum compare this to the Great Fire of Newcastle and Gateshead. We will begin to use directions, N,S,E and W as well as investigating aerial views of places using google maps.
