Class book- Troll's Treasure

Write an Adventure/Quest story

Become a skald - a Viking storyteller! Children explore the features of sagas, including fantastic monsters and magical weapons. Using a saga planner they plan and write their own mini-sagas

Stories that raise dilemmas

- Read as a serial story and record each dilemma as it appears. What are the possible solutions?
- Predict outcome of the dilemmas and write own ending, then finish reading original story and compare these.
- Dramatise relevant 'dilemma' scenes, exploring possible outcomes.
- Take on the role of a Viking child and write advice for one of the characters on how to resolve their dilemma.

Poetry

Traditional poems

Read a selection of traditional poems by Charles Causley and Eleanor Farjeon with children. Explore the vocabulary of sounds and study the use of adjectives and adverbs/adverbials as descriptions. Children write poetry inspired by Sounds in the Evening and I am the Song

Numeracy

Fractions

Recognise, find and write fractions of objects with small denominators.

Recognise and show, using diagrams, equivalent fractions with small denominators.

Add and subtract fractions of the same denominator within one whole.

Statistics

Interpret and present data using bar charts, pictographs and tables.

Solve one step and two step problems such as 'how many more/less' using information presented in bar charts, pictographs and tables.

Geometry (geography link)

Recognise angles as property of shape or description of a turn.

Identify right angles, recognize that two right angles make a half turn, three make a three quarter turn, and four a whole turn.

Identify angles that are greater or less than a right angle.

Addition and Subtraction

Add and subtract numbers with up to three digits using formal written method of column addition and subtraction.

Solve problems such as missing number problems, using number facts, place value and two step problems.

History & Geography

Look at why the Vikings raided and how they travelled, researching Longboats.

Design and build a Viking Longboat.

Explore the Viking Occupation of Lindisfarne. Use maps and grid references.

Visit to Lindisfarne - enrichment activity.

Compare Viking trading and modern trading.

Compare and contrast rural North East (Lindisfarne) to Wallsend.

Science

Sound

Identify how sounds are made, associating some of them with something vibrating

Recognise that vibrations from sounds travel through a medium to the ear

Recognise that sounds get fainter as the distance from the sound source increases

Find patterns between the pitch of a sound and features of the object that produced it

Find patterns between the volume of a sound and the strength of the vibrations that produced it
