

English including Grammar

Persuasive Writing

Year 3 will be learning to select and use information to use persuasively both for spoken presentations and written letters.

Year 3 will also be visiting **The 2 Steves** at the library and exploring some of their texts.

Poetry

We will be learning to recognise different forms of poetry, and using what we have learnt to write poems about Christmas.

Spelling, grammar and punctuation will be taught on a daily basis and will be incorporated into all writing.

ICT and Computing

In ICT we will be completing our work with Scratch Jr and then learning to use search technologies effectively, and understanding how to select the best results.

We will also be making use of different apps on the iPads in class.

Mathematics including Arithmetic

Multiplication and Division

Children will learn to recall and use multiplication and division facts for the 3, 4 and 8 multiplication tables. They will learn calculations using the multiplication tables that they know, using mental and progressing to formal written methods.

Fractions

Year 3 will recognise, find and write fractions of a discrete set of objects, and recognise and use fractions as numbers.

Geometry

We will be learning to draw, describe and make shapes using modelling materials
We will recognise angles as a property of shape or a description of a turn.

Statistics

We will learn to interpret and present data using bar charts, pictograms and tables.

Science

This term we will be learning about the animals (including humans), and nutrition.

We will learn that animals, including humans, need the right types and amount of nutrition, and that they cannot make their own food; they get nutrition from what they eat

We will learn that humans and some other animals have skeletons and muscles for support, protection and movement.

These lessons will be taught by carrying out a variety of investigations.

PE

Our coaches will teach PE. They will be teaching gymnastics.

Art & DT

This half term Year 3 will be painting with a focus on brush techniques, different types of paint, how to mix colours and create new ones.

Music

Christmas songs and contemporary Christmas music leading to a performance with instruments.

Spanish

The children will continue to learn Spanish and learn basic vocabulary.

History & Geography

The topic this half term is 'Brilliant Brazil'. We will make comparisons between Brazil and England in terms of physical geography (climate zones, biomes and vegetation belts, rivers, mountains, volcanoes and earthquakes, and the water cycle) and human geography (land use, trade links, and the distribution of natural resources).

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RE and PSHCE

PSHCE-Celebrating Differences' look at different cultures, religions, different communities and the vibrancy this brings to life.

In R.E we will be looking at the different religions around the world.
