

English including Grammar

Roman Myths

Year 3 will continue to develop their writing skills with myths, and will use Talk for Writing to help them develop their own ideas.

Fiction

We will do Talk for Writing with 'The Monster Over the Hill' by Daniel Morden.

Poetry

We will be learning to recognise different forms of poetry, and writing some Easter poems in different styles.

Spelling, grammar and punctuation will be taught on a daily basis and will be incorporated into all writing.

ICT and Computing

This half term, ICT will be taught in tandem with Art, as children will be using iPads and computers to create digital media and this will teach them new ICT skills. We will also be making use of different apps on the iPads in class.

Pirates



Mathematics including Arithmetic

Multiplication and Division

Children will learn to recall and use multiplication and division facts for the 3, 4 and 8 multiplication tables. They will learn calculations using the multiplication tables that they know, using mental and continuing with the formal written methods.

Fractions

Year 3 will recognise that tenths arise from dividing an object into 10 equal parts and in dividing quantities by 10.

Geometry

We will be learning to draw, describe and make shapes using modelling materials. We will identify whether angles are greater than or less than a right angle.

Statistics

We will learn to interpret and present data using bar charts, pictograms and tables.

Science

This term we will be learning about magnets and forces.

We will:

- compare how things move on different surfaces
- observe how magnets attract or repel each other and some materials
- compare and group together a variety of everyday materials on the basis of whether they are attracted to a magnet,
- identify some magnetic materials
- describe magnets as having two poles
- predict whether two magnets will attract or repel each other,

PE

Our coaches will continue to teach PE to year 3.

Art & DT

This half term year 3 will be using iPad and desktop computers to design and make wallpaper, wrapping paper and contemporary art.

Music

How the combined musical elements can be organised within musical structures and used to communicate different moods and effects.

Spanish

The children will continue to learn Spanish and learn basic vocabulary.

History & Geography

The topic this half term is 'Pirates'. We will be learning to use maps, atlases and globes, to locate countries and describe features studied. We will also be learning to use the eight points of a compass, four and six-figure grid references, symbols and keys.

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RE and PSHCE

PSHCE-Celebrating Differences' look at different cultures, religions, different communities and the vibrancy this brings to life.

In R.E we will be looking at the different religions around the world.
